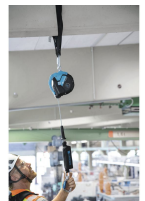


# EXHELON - steel cable - 47854

The EXHELON fall arrester complies with EN 360:2023 and is the safest, most comfortable and most attractive self-retracting lifeline on the market.

## Product description

- Safety: EXHELON offers three fall indicators: one in the connector, one in the shock-absorbing lanyard, and one in the ZARGES ZmartCheck - an integrated NFC tag for inspections and tests.
- Comfort: The ergonomically designed handle facilitates easy carrying. The completely redesigned housing, exclusive to ZARGES, offers maximum carrying comfort.
- The swivel at the top and bottom ensures excellent freedom of movement while keeping the drop distance short.
- The device is suitable for a maximum user weight of 150 kg and has been tested in accordance with RfU 11.060 for horizontal use with edge protection.
- It is available in lengths of 3, 6, 10 or 15 metres, made of webbing, galvanised steel or stainless steel.
- The equipment includes an aluminium tri-lock with captive pin on the anchor point side and an aluminium tri-lock connector on the full body harness side.
- Equipped with energy absorber according to EN 355.
- Equipped with galvanized cable.
